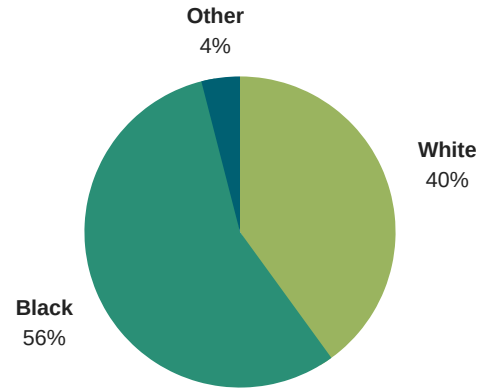

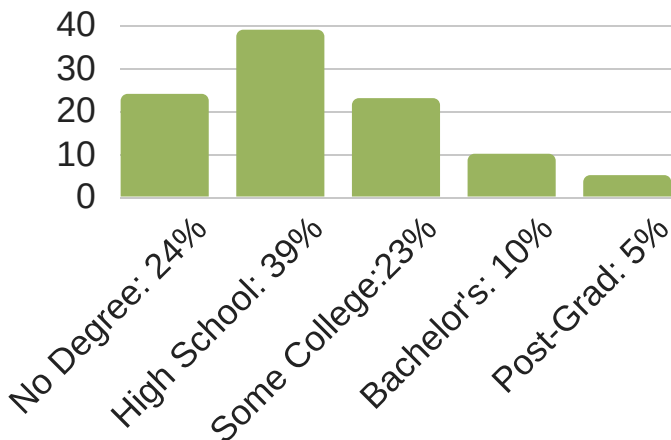
Median Value of Owner-Occupied Housing
